



Year 5/6 Residential trip to Fairbourne 2019

Trip dates

- ▶ Group 1 Monday 23rd September - Wednesday 25th September 2019
- ▶ Group 2 Wednesday 25th September - Friday 27th September 2019
- ▶ Group 3 Monday 30th September - Wednesday 2nd October 2019



Accommodation

- ▶ <https://www.panteinionhall.co.uk>
- ▶ Staff and children's rooms are all on the first floor
- ▶ Some rooms are en-suite whilst a wet room is available for those without
- ▶ Rooms vary in size from 4 beds to 6/7 beds depending on numbers
- ▶ Large living and dining room down stairs
- ▶ All dietary requirements are catered for



Arrangements on day of departure

- ▶ Children arrive at school at the normal time dressed in their own clothes - suitable walking shoes need to be worn.
- ▶ Children bring in their overnight bags and sleeping bags and leave them in the hall. All bags must be labelled with your child's name.
- ▶ Children with inhalers must keep them in their day bags (rucksack), but any other medication must be named and given to the designated member of staff who will be situated in the hall.
- ▶ Children need to keep their day bags with them and take them back up to their classrooms.
- ▶ Day bags should have in them: a packed lunch, refillable drinks bottle (labelled with a name), waterproof coat, travel game if desired, pencil and field notebook (provided by the school).

Outline of day 1 (subject to change depending on tides and weather)

- ▶ Leave school between 9.15 - 9.30 am (Parents are welcome to wait at the school gate to wave the children off)
- ▶ Arrive in Fairbourne and complete mapping activity
- ▶ Lunch
- ▶ Building shelters on the beach
- ▶ Further fieldwork activities in Fairbourne
- ▶ Walk up to Panteinion Hall
- ▶ Sort rooms, followed by evening meal
- ▶ Evening activities based at the hall
- ▶ Hot drink and story before bed

Outline of day 2

- ▶ Breakfast
- ▶ Walk to Barmouth via Fairbourne and the dyke
- ▶ Lunch (provided by the hall)
- ▶ Fieldwork activities in Barmouth (e.g. mapping, tourist surveys, building use surveys)
- ▶ Shopping for souvenirs (children can bring a maximum of £5 to spend in Barmouth or at Panteinion Hall)
- ▶ Play time on the beach
- ▶ Catch train back to Fairbourne
- ▶ Walk back up to Panteinion Hall
- ▶ Evening meal
- ▶ Showers
- ▶ Evening activities based at the hall
- ▶ Hot drink before bed

Outline of day 3

- ▶ Breakfast
- ▶ Pack bags and clear rooms
- ▶ Walk to Fairbourne
- ▶ Trip on miniature steam train to sand spit
- ▶ Return to Fairbourne
- ▶ Continue building rock shelters
- ▶ Lunch (provided by the hall)
- ▶ Return to school for approximately 4.00pm



Additional information

- ▶ We request that children do not bring mobile phones or any other electronic device - children will not be able to charge their devices and phone signal is weak.
- ▶ Children may bring a camera - these are for the children to look after themselves and we accept no responsibility for lost or damaged cameras
- ▶ In the event of an emergency at home, you can contact school, who will pass a message on during school hours or you can contact Panteinion Hall directly on 01341 250519 outside of school hours.
- ▶ In the event of an emergency on the trip we will contact you via the contact details you have provided.
- ▶ Children may bring with them one small bag of sweets if desired.
- ▶ Day bags should preferably be a rucksack that can be carried on both shoulders.

Kit List

Children will need **two** bags - a day bag and a bag containing overnight items.

Day Bag: This should be packed with the following ready to use on the first day of the trip.

Packed lunch & drink (in a named refillable container)

Waterproof coat (We have some waterproof cagoules and rucksacks in school, children wishing to borrow these should see their class teacher)

Clipboard (provided by school), pencil & rubber

Children should be wearing comfortable clothing, including a sweatshirt/jumper and footwear suitable for walking - trainers are satisfactory.

Overnight bag: (labelled with the child's name)

Nightwear

Underclothes and socks (spare pairs of socks necessary)

Indoor shoes (slippers/pumps etc.)

Shoes/trainers

Shirts/blouses

Trousers/jeans/shorts!!

Toiletries (toothpaste, soap, towels etc.)

Jumper

Teddy Bear!

A book

Shower Cap

Large Towel

An indoor game (travelling chess, cards etc.) Cameras may be brought (child to be responsible)

A torch will not be necessary (toilets and indoor corridors will be lit at night)

Children will need a **sleeping bag**. (Please see one of the staff if there is a problem)

Mobiles and expensive equipment should be left at home - no mobile phone reception at Panteinion
