<p>RESPONSIBILITY</p>	<p>Our high quality history and geography curriculum inspires curiosity and fascination about the world, its people and its past. Our history and geography curriculums allow our children to develop our three core values of responsibility resilience and respect.</p> <p>Within the history curriculum, children develop respect for and knowledge about Britain's past and that of the wider world. It inspires children to develop resilience to know more about the past, encouraging them to ask perceptive questions, think critically, weigh evidence, sift arguments and develop perspective and judgement. Opportunities to work alongside peers encourages respect, whilst also allowing our children to use each other to develop and deepen their own understanding.</p>
<p>RESILIENCE</p>	<p>By exploring the significant historical events, people and places in their own locality, children develop a better understanding of their community and the historical factors that have shaped it. Respect for and understanding of significant individuals in the past, also forms a fundamental part of our curriculum and children are encouraged to explore and consider how these individuals have contributed to national and international achievements.</p>
<p>RESPECT</p>	<p>Within the geography curriculum, children develop respect for and knowledge about the world, the United Kingdom and their locality. Children will develop a strong sense of the local and wider community through exploring locational and place knowledge, whilst respect for the world is nurtured through a wide range of rich opportunities in human and physical geography, fieldwork and geographical skills. In providing children the opportunity to research and explore their own curiosities about the world, they will develop their ability to persevere to broaden their knowledge about the world and deepen their geographical understanding.</p> <p>Our history and geography curriculums provide clear progression in both skills and knowledge.
