<p>RESPONSIBILITY</p>	<p>As a Church of England School, Religious Education is fundamental to developing the children's understanding of their role in a Church School and a multicultural society. The children understand they have a responsibility to be part of the school community. They learn how to be a valued member of this community and their role within it. They also understand that Christianity is a global faith and they are part of the local Church as well as the wider global Christian community.</p>
<p>RESILIENCE</p>	<p>They study key Christian values and about the other main world religions which allows them to understand and respect the beliefs and views of all. Pupils are taught to respect each other, their teachers and all members in the school and broader communities. Through studying the bible and other religious texts, pupils learn that resilience can be important to success in life. They are encouraged to embrace challenges in their learning and life and to persevere despite these.</p>
